

English 8 – Parts of Speech: The Card Game

Task: In small groups, create a card game that helps players to learn and study the parts of speech.

What I Need:

1. A card game utilizing a standard deck of playing cards. This game should be for at least two players, and should have a clearly designed system for winning.
2. A written set of rules explaining how to play. An optional demonstration of gameplay will also be accepted.

How you will be marked:

The Game: You have a playable game with a clear way of determining who wins.

The Rules: Your written explanation is clear, proof read, and presented neatly.

Playability: Your game has a degree of challenge and strategy, with good replay-ability. (This means not too easy, not too hard, and offers some variation and originality each time you play.)

Extras: A custom made package with illustrations, color, and appeal that would entice a consumer to buy your product.

Keep in Mind...

- There are lots of ways to score or win. Who is the fastest to respond? Who is the first to get rid of their cards? Who accumulates the most points? Think of card games you already know, then try to make adjustments to include the parts of speech.
- Strive to include the parts of speech and examples within actual sentences. Simply defining the parts is a little boring; giving one-word examples is a little better; using the right words in complex sentences to score lots of points is even better.
- Yes, you can TOTALLY construct other elements (pre-made sentences? Game board?) to make your game even better!
